A PROJECT at Boston's Pilgrim Hospital has been shortlisted in the Service Transformation category of the East Midlands Health and Social Care Awards.

The sleep apnoea project, run by consultant Michael Oko, involves treating patients for the relatively common condition sleep apnoea.

The treatment service was launched 18 months ago and is aimed at diagnosing and treating the condition.

If this wins its category it could be in the running for a national award. The awards are organised by the Department of Health in partnership with the NHS Institute for Innovation and Improvement to recognise the hard work and dedication of healthcare staff in the projects they run.
